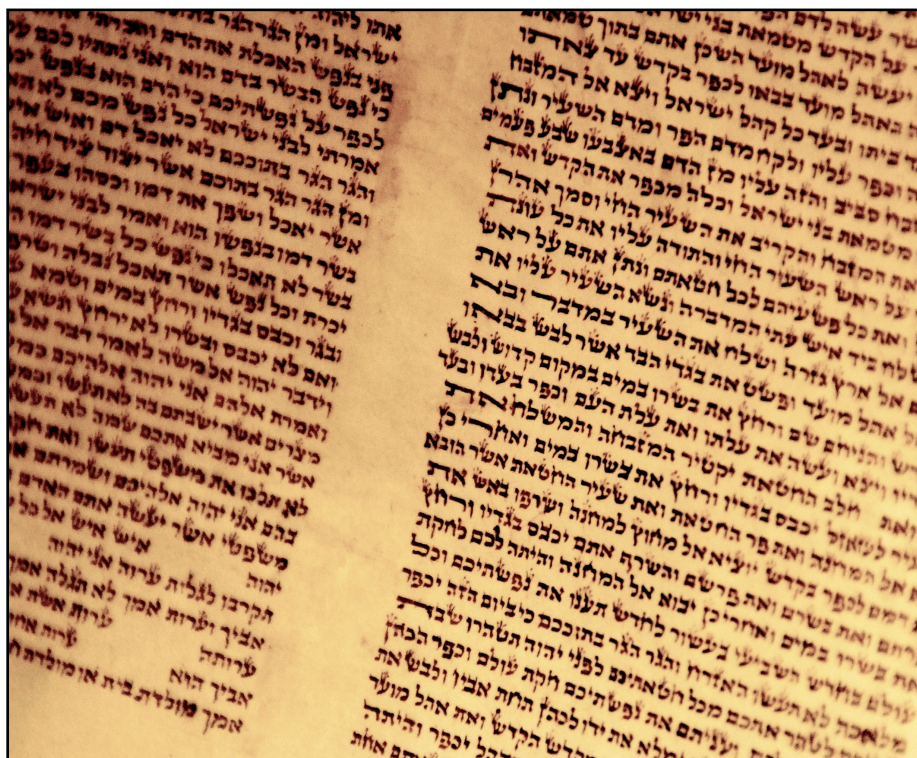

John 10:35

The Bible tells us in Ecclesiastes 3:14 that whatever GOD does lasts forever. When the Word of God was given and completed, it could never be broken. The word broken refers to being loose, melted, destroyed or put off. God's Word retained its integrity throughout time and throughout the years. Yet, there

stands a far more personal and important application: no matter the opinions and actions of men, the scripture cannot be broken. It stands fast, and it stands unhindered, unchanged and unpolluted because it is upheld by the Almighty God of the Universe. Its content will not change, its words will not change, because the Lord does not change (Malachi 3:6.) The Bible stands in the midst of the fiercest contest, and the most

formidable challenge.

The Bible stands despite Man's opposition. The Jews were opposed to the Lord Jesus when He said, "I and my Father are one. (John 10: 30)" The Word of God will often bring division. The Word of God divides the truth from error; the one seeking the truth will

be drawn to it, and the other who rejects the truth will be repelled by it. Throughout the centuries, institutions such as the Roman Catholic Church have sought to keep the Bible from the layman and impose unscriptural laws to bind man to themselves, but the Bible stood through brave man such as John Wycliffe and William Tyndale who, for the love of the Word of God, gave their lives. Those who burned William Tyndale at the stake are today themselves in the flames of hell, but the Word of God still stands.

There is yet a different form of opposition, one which is more subtle and sinister. The opposition of half-truths, like the devil's question in Genesis 3:1. The devil knows that many will give their lives to defend the Bible as a whole, but because many will not read or study the Scriptures, there will be opposition to the word through untruths and half-truths. "We are all the same, we all lead people to heaven" says one; " God helps those who help themselves" says another. Are these from the Bible? These statements are not found in the Word of God and it prejudices our minds against the word of the Lord. Yet, the Bible cannot be broken despite what we think or man's opinions.

Baptists and Catholics Together for Movie Making

Sherwood Baptist Church, maker of the movies *Flywheel*, *Facing the Giants*, and *Fireproof*, promotes unity with the Roman Catholic Church for the purpose of bringing America back to God. Sherwood Baptist is located in Albany, Georgia, in the midst of the Bible belt, but Pastor Michael Catt doesn't believe what the Bible says about separation from heresy (Romans 16:17; 2 Corinthians 6:14; 2 Timothy 3:5). The church is aggressively seeking Roman Catholic participation in the promotion of its new movie *Courageous*. We understand that "Catholics will be sent to the Sherwood Baptist Church's Courageous Resources site for Catholics," and as one friend observed, "Those who call themselves Christians will see this Catholic Resources page and be led to believe that Catholics and Christians are Brothers and Sisters in Christ." Sherwood Baptist invited the *National Catholic Register* to view the filming of the movie and Pastor Catt gave the reporter, Matthew Warner, a warm, positive ecumenical interview which was published on the Catholic publication's web site June 20, 2010. Catt made the following statement in this interview: "When we go across the country and do these screenings, we meet people from every denomination you can imagine, and we instantly have a fellowship and a brotherhood because we have one thing we know that we have in common: we're family. SWEDISH SCHOOL BANS "HIM" AND "HER"

In an effort to promote unisex and to break down gender stereotypes, a Swedish preschool has banned children from being called "him" or "her." The Egalia school in Stockholm is "on a mission to break down gender roles," which is a core mission in the national curriculum for Swedish preschools" ("You're All Equal Here," *Daily Mail*, June 27, 2011). Teacher Jenny Johnsson criticizes the fact that "society expects girls to be girly, nice and pretty and boys to be manly, rough and outgoing." Nearly all of the school's children's books deal with homosexual couples, single parents or adopted children. The school "places a special emphasis on fostering an environment tolerant of gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender people." This is not education; it is humanistic brainwashing, and the Swedish model is the future of public schools in America, with California already leading the way.



Keeping Males and Females in Balance

The following is from *Creation Moments*, May 13, 2011: "Have you ever wondered how, over thousands of years, the population balance between males and females remains roughly even? Science has learned that there seems to be several mechanisms working together to keep things balanced, providing a fail-safe system. Many species have gene transfer systems that always produce a one-to-one ratio in the next generation. However, what happens if, perhaps due to a natural disaster, the balance is lost between males and females in a population? Scientists have been testing a theory that when either sex is significantly underrepresented, its increased contribution to the next generation brings things back into balance. This amazing theory is supported by recent studies on the Atlantic silverside fish. Studies show that even when the population has three males for every female, the ratio returns to 50-50 within four-to-six generations! According to evolution, males and females should not have developed at all. Evolutionary doctrine says that if males and females should develop, evolutionary forces will not favor sexual reproduction. The Bible says that God not only created male and female, but that the creation is designed with great wisdom. What science is learning about how balance is maintained between the sexes contradicts evolution and supports the Bible."

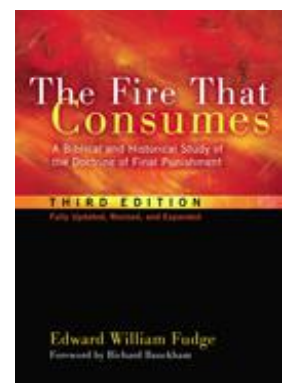

family members because we are brother and sisters in Christ, and it doesn't matter what labels we put on." This confused Southern Baptist pastor obviously doesn't believe Jesus' warning about the coming of many false teachers who will teach error in such a subtle manner that even the elect will be deceived if that were possible (Matthew 7:15; 24:11, 24). Catt doesn't seem to believe Jesus' statement that many who profess Christ as "Lord, Lord" are actually lost (Matthew 7:21-23). Catt doesn't seem to believe what Paul through the Holy Spirit warned about false christs and false gospels and false spirits (2 Corinthians 11:1-3) and the great falling away from the truth in the end times (2 Timothy 3:5; 4:3-4). Pastor Catt might protest that he does believe these things, but if so he certainly does not know how to act on them in any practical manner. Billy Atwell, another Catholic blogger who was invited to view the filming of *Courageous*, said that for Baptists and Catholics to work together "we just need a common orthodox Christian framework, and to agree on the issue at hand" ("From Fireproof to Courageous," *Catholic Online*, June 18, 2010). To imply that Baptists and Roman Catholics share a common orthodox framework, is a gross error. Bible-believing Baptists and Catholics don't share the same view of the gospel, for example, which is certainly a fundamental aspect of Christian orthodoxy. The Bible teaches that salvation is by grace *alone* through faith in Christ *alone* without works or sacraments, whereas at the Council of Trent Rome actually cursed those who believe this gospel. (See "How Rome Denies Salvation by Grace Alone" at the Way of Life web site.) When Atwell refers to the "issue at hand" he is referring to the theme of *Courageous*, which is fatherhood. Thus we are told that it is fine for Baptists and Catholics to unite for fatherhood. But good fatherhood defined biblically requires that fathers lead their children to Christ, which requires a sound gospel. Further, good fatherhood requires that fathers lead their families in obedience to the "whole counsel of God" and teach their children to "observe ALL things" that Christ has commanded us in Scripture (Matthew 28:19-20). Good fatherhood, therefore, requires raising one's family in a thorough-going Biblicist church, and it does not allow Bible-believing fathers to yoke together in ministry and spiritual fellowship with those who teach false gospels and gross heresies (e.g., the papacy, mariolatry, sacramentalism, baptismal regeneration, the priesthood, monasticism, enforced celibacy, reverence of relics, purgatory, Rome as the head of all churches). Sherwood Baptist is doubtless sincerely trying to help America with its movies, but it is blind to the fact that it represents the very type of shallow, worldly, lukewarm Christianity that has gotten the country into the mess that it is in.

EVANGELICAL SCHOLAR SAYS THE DOCTRINE OF ETERNAL TORMENT IS A SCANDAL AGAINST GOD'S CHARACTER

Edward Fudge, author of *The Fire that Consumes: A Biblical and Historical Study of the Doctrine of Final Punishment*, says that the doctrine of eternal torment is a "horrible scandal against the character of God Himself" ("Interview: Scholar Edward Fudge," *Christian Post*, June 23, 2011). Fudge, who believes that the unsaved are annihilated, says that the God who would cast people into fire to suffer eternal torment "doesn't sound like the God that I know and see in Jesus Christ." This is a rapidly growing sentiment among "evangelicals." Rob Bell says that the God who would send the unsaved to eternal hell is "terrifying and traumatizing and unbearable" (*Love Wins*, Kindle location 1273-1287, 2098-2113). Brian McLaren agrees with that. So does the author of *The Shack*, a book which is very popular among evangelicals, including Southern Baptists. The author of *The Shack* says that the God who "watches from a distance and judges sin" is "a Christianized version of Zeus." All of this reminds us of the modernist G. Bromley Oxnam, who called the sin-hating God of the Old Testament "a dirty bully" in his 1944 book *Preaching in a Revolutionary Age*. A half century ago evangelical leaders renounced "separatism" and determined

to associate with modernists by remaining in corrupt denominations and schools and by sitting at their feet for theological education. This "infiltration technique" hasn't "evangelicalized" the modernists, but it has definitely modernized the evangelicals.

CHIEF RABBI SAYS ENGLAND'S EQUALITY LAWS LEADING TO NEW MAYFLOWER EXODUS

The following is excerpted from "Chief Rabbi," *The Telegraph*, July 1, 2011: "New equality laws are forcing religious people to flee the country because they are being denied the freedom to live in accordance with their beliefs, the Chief Rabbi, Lord Sacks, has warned. The Orthodox



Jewish leader claimed that anti-discrimination policies had fuelled an 'erosion of religious liberty' in Britain that was leading to a new 'Mayflower', a reference to the flight of the persecuted Pilgrim Fathers to America in the 17th century.

His comments follow growing alarm from leading religious figures over the increasing influence of equality laws. The former Archbishop of Canterbury, Lord Carey, has called on the Prime Minister to review equality legislation amid concerns that religious

freedoms and Britain's Christian heritage are under threat. Speaking to the House of Commons public administration select committee, Lord Sacks said there was 'no doubt' numbers of religious believers in Britain were 'extraordinarily' low. He continued: 'I share a real concern that the attempt to impose the current prevailing template of equality and discrimination on religious organisations is an erosion of religious liberty. We are beginning to move back to where we came in in the 17th century -- a whole lot of people on the Mayflower leaving to find religious freedom elsewhere.' ... Andrea Minichiello Williams, director of the Christian Legal Centre, welcomed Lord Sacks' remarks. 'There has been a significant curtailing of religious freedom in this nation, due to the equalities culture and the imposition of political correctness on the public,' she said. 'These days, you can lose your job if you have incorrect views.'"

CHARLES STANLEY PROMOTING CONTEMPLATIVE MYSTICISM

Two issues of Stanley's *In Touch* magazine have featured contemplatives. A January 2011 article entitled "The Craft of Stability" focuses on the Rutba House, which is the home of contemplative author Jonathan Wilson-Hartgrove (shown right). *In Touch* admits that Rutba's principles are borrowed from St. Benedict's "rule of life" ("Contemplative Spirituality Lands on Charles Stanley's *In Touch* Magazine ... Again," Lighthouse Trails Blog, June 20, 2011). That should be reason enough to reject Rutba House, but *In Touch* has only praise for it. The *In Touch* article endorses Wilson-Hartgrove even though his books teach Roman Catholic contemplation and are recommended by emergents such as Brian McLaren, Phyllis Tickle, Tony Campolo, and Richard Rohr, all of whom deny the traditional Bible doctrine of the blood atonement and believe that it is possible to be saved apart from faith in Christ. In his book *The Wisdom of Stability*, Wilson-Hartgrove promotes the Catholic-Buddhist Thomas Merton and New Age Catholics

Teilhard de Chardin and Joan Chittister (who says we must become "in tune with the cosmic voice of God"). In January 2010 *In Touch* published an article by Joseph Bentz about

two contemplative proponents, Anne Lamott and Sara Miles, the latter being a practicing lesbian who has lived with her lesbian partner for many years ("Letter to Charles Stanley," Lighthouse Trails, Jan. 18, 2010). In a 2007 interview with the *San Francisco Chronicle*, Miles said that "the Bible is a collection of documents that is remade every time somebody reads it" and ridiculed the idea that we can dogmatically say "the Bible says this or that thing is good or bad."



THE WHOLE WORLD IMAGINING A VAIN THING

The Psalmist prophesied that the whole world will imagine a vain thing, which is to cast off "the bands" of God and Christ. "Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us" (Psalm 2:1-3). The word translated "anointed" is the Hebrew *messiah*, which is the same as the Greek *Christ*. It refers, of course, to Jesus, who is revealed in the same Psalm as the Son of God (verse 7). This vain imagination is spreading across the globe with a

great fervor today, even among professing Christians. John Lennon's song "Imagine" has become an anthem of sorts for this rebellion, and it is interesting that it uses exactly the same word used by the Psalmist 3,000 years ago. The lyrics say: "Imagine there's no heaven ... No hell below us, above us only sky ... no religion too/ You may say I'm a dreamer, but I'm not the only one/ I hope some day you'll join us, and the world will live as one." Lennon dreamed that the world would come together by imagining a unity in rebellion against God's absolute authority and against the CONTINUED NEXT PAGE....

IMAGINING.....

exclusiveness of salvation through His Son. I've heard "Imagine" sung and played practically everywhere I have traveled in this world (more than 30 countries). It has been sung as a duet by Dolly Parton and the homosexual rocker Elton John. It was sung by Bill Clinton with a Jewish and Arab children's choir. It was used by a short-term missionary P.E.A.C.E. team from Rick Warren's Saddleback Church in August 2006 as part of a video slide show that was posted on YouTube. I used to love that song before I was saved ("Imagine" came out in 1971, when I was in the

apex of my run from God), and I, too, didn't believe in hell or in a God that would send people to hell. But I thank the Lord for His mercy in opening my blinded eyes.

COUNTRY MUSIC DRINKING THEME

Recently *The Boot* online magazine voted on the top 20 "Drinking" songs. This gives a crystal clear look at the character of Country music and how drinking is glorified. Only the Lord knows how many Country music fans have committed violent acts, estranged their children and friends, committed fornication and adultery, destroyed their marriages, crashed their vehicles, ruined their health, died before their time, and lost their souls -- all because of "drinking." Consider a few examples: "WHISKEY RIVER" by Willie Nelson (1973): "Whiskey River take my mind / Don't let her mem'ry torture me. / Whiskey River, don't run dry / You're all I've got, take care of me." "FRIENDS IN LOW PLACES" by Garth Brooks (1990): "I've got friends in low places / Where the whiskey drowns / And the beer chases my blues away / And I'll be OK." "ALL MY ROWDY FRIENDS" by Hank Williams, Jr. (1984): "Do you wanna drink? / Do ya wanna party? / ... I cooked a pig in the ground, we got some beer on ice / And all my rowdy friends are coming over tonight." "I GOTTA GET DRUNK" by George Jones, Merle Haggard, Willie Nelson (1970): "A

lot of doctors tell me / That I'd better start slowing it down / But there's more old drunks than there are old doctors / So I guess we'd better have another round." "MARGARITAVILLE" by Jimmy Buffett (1977): "There's booze in the blender / And soon it will render / That frozen concoction that helps me hang on." The Bible says: "Who hath woe? who hath sorrow? who hath contentions? who hath babbling? who hath wounds without cause? who hath redness of eyes? They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine. Look not thou upon the wine when it is red, when it giveth his colour in the cup, when it moveth itself aright. At the last it biteth like a serpent, and stingeth like an adder. Thine eyes shall behold strange women, and thine heart shall utter perverse things. Yea, thou shalt be as he that lieth down in the midst of the sea, or as he that lieth upon the top of a mast. They have stricken me, shalt thou say, and I was not sick; they have beaten me, and I felt it not: when shall I awake? I will seek it yet again" (Proverbs 23:29-35).

Conclusion

Friends in Christ, do not be discouraged by any of this. It is God's will that we know the times (1 Ch. 12:32; Mat. 16:3) and that we be as wise as serpents and harmless as doves. These things remind us that the hour is very late, and we need to be ready for the coming of the Lord. Are you sure that you are born again? Are you living for Christ day by day? "And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed. The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof" (Rom. 13:11-14).
