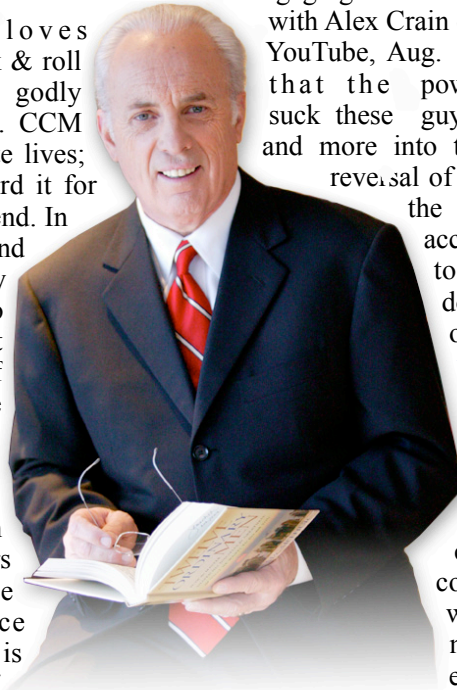

# FRIDAY CHURCH NEWS NOTES

## MacARTHUR PROMOTES CULTURAL LIBERALISM

The Contemporary Christian Music crowd loves rock & roll. Period. They simply love rock & roll and there is no biblical principle or godly argument that will pry it from their ears. CCM artists listen to secular rock in their private lives; they perform it in their concerts and record it for their albums. They don't care who they offend. In fact, they seem as eager to mock and offend the "old-fashioned Christian" as I was in my unsaved hippie-rebel days. They become so drunk on rock and so spiritually stupid that they even use secular rock in the worship of God. Consider some examples from the past few years. Granger Community Church in Granger, Indiana, featured Beatles Music as their 2007 Christmas theme. Pastor Tim Stevens said: "With Across the Universe currently in the theaters and the new Beatles-themed CThe influential John MacArthur of Grace Community Church in southern California is facing two ways in regard to the heresy of



"cultural liberalism." On one hand he reproves the emerging "new Calvinists" for their worldliness, while engaging in that very thing on the other. In an interview with Alex Crain of Christianity.com, which was posted on YouTube, Aug. 18, 2011, MacArthur says, "The fear is that the power of the world's attraction is going to suck these guys and every generation after them, more and more into the culture, and we're going to see a reversal of the Reformed revival. ... My fear is that the further this thing goes in trying to accommodate the culture, the less it's going to be able to hang on to that core doctrine" ("MacArthur Predicts Reversal of the Reformed Revival - Part 1," <http://youtu.be/xYhmo5gabQU>). MacArthur, who rightly warns that the heresy of cultural liberalism puts the next generation at risk, is referring to the popular philosophy which was enunciated by Mark Driscoll as the combination of "theological conservatism with cultural liberalism," which is not new but has always been a major element of New Evangelicalism. It entails such things as Christian rock,

## ROBOT PRISON GUARDS

Robot guards will be stationed in the Pohang city jail in South Korean next spring ("Robotic Guards," *Popular Science*, Nov. 28, 2011). The upright robots, which travel on four wheels and have a "cute," non-threatening appearance, will monitor inmates for abnormal behavior and detect prisoner violence. They will be equipped with "remote conversation function" by which "live" prison guards can communicate with prisoners via the robot's cameras, microphones, and speaker system. For the most part they will be deployed at night.



## LADY GAGA HANGS OUT WITH JESUS

In a recent interview, the blaspheming, morally outrageous rocker Lady Gaga said that she hangs out with Jesus. Speaking with *Women's Wear Daily*, the morally vacant mega-star described how she grew up with traditional Roman Catholic Christmas practices, including Santa and the Mass. She said, "I still believe in Santa. He's for sure around. He and the Easter Bunny. I've hung out with them and Jesus Christ a few times. ... They're just all really good friends." She is mocking the holy Jesus, of course, bringing Him down to the level of a silly myth. Lady Gaga is the epitome of an end-time "Christian," living after her own lusts and loving fables (2 Timothy 4:3-4). Her "Jesus" is the non-judgmental, "I don't put any obligations on you," "let's rock" *Shack* Jesus. Large numbers of professing Christians love every foolish thing that the vain pop culture drags out of the Pit.

drinking, champagne dance parties, beer brewing lessons, gambling nights, hula “worship,” analyzing R-rated movies for “edification,” and performing secular rock in the context of “worship.” What MacArthur says about the danger of cultural liberalism is true, but his condemnation of it is grossly ineffective and hypocritical because he is guilty of it. Camp Regeneration, a youth camp hosted by MacArthur for “churches throughout the nation each July,” is rife with cultural liberalism. High school boys and girls dress immodestly, engage in questionable activities (such as girls getting covered with wet mud in the presence of boys), and rock out to rap music performed by ear-ringed, tattooed hip-hop artists in an atmosphere of darkened auditoriums, flashing lights, and smoke. The Master’s College, which is headed by MacArthur, hosted a hip-hop concert in December featuring Lecrae, Trip Lee, Tadashii, Sho Baraka, DJ Official, and THI’S L. The Master’s College students produce pop/rap/country rock videos with full blown dance routines and covers of secular rock songs. They host a Fall Thing event that is extremely worldly. This year the theme was “Unrestricted Reality,” and the students donned costumes imitating characters from Star Wars, sci-fi fantasy, super heroes, and the pop culture in general. This plays right into the hands of the culture’s fascination with fantasy and the devil’s use of it to corrupt men’s minds. The young people wouldn’t want to dress up this way unless their minds and hearts were already in love with Hollywood. The Master’s College’s annual Week of Welcome features beach activities and pool parties complete with girls in tight and very skimpy bathing suits. (All of this is evident from the photos placed at the Flickr pages owned by the camp and school and from YouTube clips. See <http://www.pccmonroe.org/2011/10.htm>.) Can someone tell me how MacArthur is leading the way against the adaptation of the sensual pop culture and why he is a safe “conservative” to follow? He is correct in observing that cultural liberalism will ruin the youth and eventually destroy sound doctrine, and his own flock will be the proof of it, as will the flocks of every foolish pastor that follows in his footsteps. Many fundamental Baptists are on the same destructive path, as we have documented in the free eBook “Biblical Separatism and Its Collapse Among Fundamental Baptists.” See [http://wayoflife.org/free\\_ebooks.html](http://wayoflife.org/free_ebooks.html).

**SHRINKING POOL OF SAFE HAVENS**

“Shrinking Pool of Safe Havens” is the title of a Reuters report on the global economy published on November 26. It says, “The universe for safe-haven assets is shrinking fast.” Indeed, the vaunted modern global economy is shaking at its very foundation, and Bible prophecy indicates that things will get worse. Actually, there is no safe haven in this world and never has been, not for your money and not for your soul. And even if there were a safe financial investment haven, it would only be temporary in the extreme, since life is so short. The Lord Jesus addressed the issue of finances several times. He told of a foolish rich man who hoarded up his goods for “many years” in order to take his ease, eat, drink, and be merry. “But God said unto him, Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee: then whose shall those things be, which thou hast provided?” (Luke 12:16-21). That is a question that every man and woman must ask. When the plug is pulled on your frail earthly existence and God requires an accounting, where will you stand? Where will you go? We can’t take anything physical with us. The ancient prophet Job wisely said, “Naked came I out of my mother’s womb, and naked shall I return thither” (Job 1:21). The wise individual plans for the future, not just the next year or 10, but for eternity. He does that through salvation and saving. In taking heed to the Revelation that God has so mercifully given in the Bible, we learn that God is a holy Judge, that all men are

sinners who have broken God’s laws, and that the only way of salvation is through the propitiation that God Himself has made for man’s sins through the sacrifice of His Son on the cross. The individual receives this salvation through repentance of his sins and faith in Christ. Once we are saved, we can then start saving in God’s eternal bank. Jesus said: “Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also” (Matthew 6:19-21). The believer does not have to trust in this world’s shaky investment schemes. He can lay up eternal treasures in heaven through service to his merciful Saviour. And he can trust in God’s promises, such as Psalm 37:25. “I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.”

**AMERICAN AIRLINES HEAD STEPS DOWN IN DISAGREEMENT OVER BANKRUPTCY**

When American Airlines filed for bankruptcy, chief executive Gerald Arpey stepped down for conscience' sake. In an op-ed in the *New York Times*, Michael Lindsay said, "Arpey split with his employer of 30 years out of a belief that bankruptcy was morally wrong, and that he could

not, in good conscience, lead an organization that followed this familiar path." He did this in spite of the fact that he had no severance package and his company stock will likely be worthless. We have no idea if Arpey is a

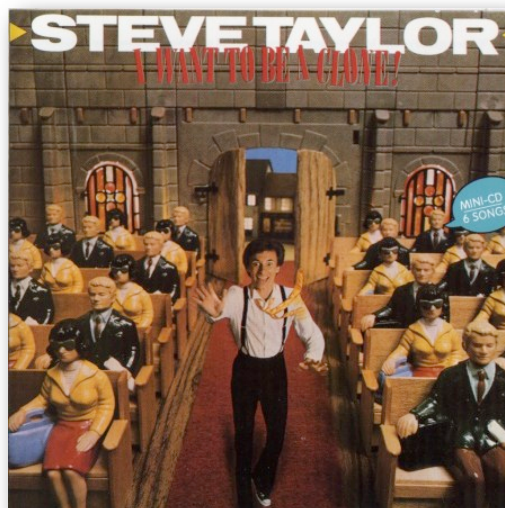
professing Christian, but his action is commendable in this day of pursuing wealth at all costs. It recalls the words of Psalm 15:4, "He that sweareth to his own hurt, and changeth not." God's law requires us to be honest, to speak truth, to be men and women of our words. When we make financial contracts, we are obligated before God to repay. To walk away from a debt and forget it is sin, unless it has been forgiven. If there are extenuating circumstances beyond one's control, there is nothing wrong with attempting to change the terms of repayment or even to beg forgiveness of the debt in part or in whole. The believer is to be merciful, willing to forgive debts, remembering the great debt that God has given us in Christ (Mat. 6:12). But since the borrower is servant to the lender (Prov. 22:7), those decisions are not in the borrower's control.

**SAUDI KING BUILDS INTERFAITH CENTER FOR WORLD PEACE**

Saudi King Abdullah's has built an Interfaith Center in Vienna to foster world peace. The King Abdullah Bin Abdulaziz International Center for Interreligious and Intercultural Dialogue will mostly be financed by the Islamic Saudi government. The governing body of the interfaith center will be composed of representatives from Islam (Sunni and Shiite), Roman Catholic, Anglican, Greek Orthodox, Buddhism, Hinduism, and Judaism. During a ceremony in Vienna, Saudi Arabian Foreign Minister said that "world peace cannot exist without peace between the world's religions" ("King Abdullah's Interfaith Center," *Christian Post*, Oct. 17, 2011). Abdullah says he conceived the idea after meeting with Pope Benedict at the Vatican in 2007. Since the center's founding document calls for 'freedom of thought, conscience and religion,' we suggest that the place to start would be Saudi Arabia itself. The Saudi government is one of the most oppressive on earth. It grants zero religious liberty; there are no public non-Muslim houses of worship; Christianity is forbidden; Jews are forbidden; Muslims who leave Islam risk execution for apostasy. Saudi Arabia was the breeding ground for the murderous Al Qaeda. "For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief" (1 Thessalonians 5:3-4).

**CCM MUSICIANS MOCK FUNDAMENTALISTS**

Christian rock was birthed in the Jesus People movement of the 1970s. Instead of renouncing their old music, the Jesus hippies used rock & roll to create Christian rock and thumbed their noses at anyone who believed it was unscriptural and unholy. Larry Norman led the way with his 1975 hit "Why Should the Devil Have All the Good Music?" The lyrics went like this: "They say rock 'n' roll is wrong ... They say cut my hair/ They're driving me insane. ... Just give me a song that has a beat/ Just give me a song that moves my feet/ I don't like none of those funeral



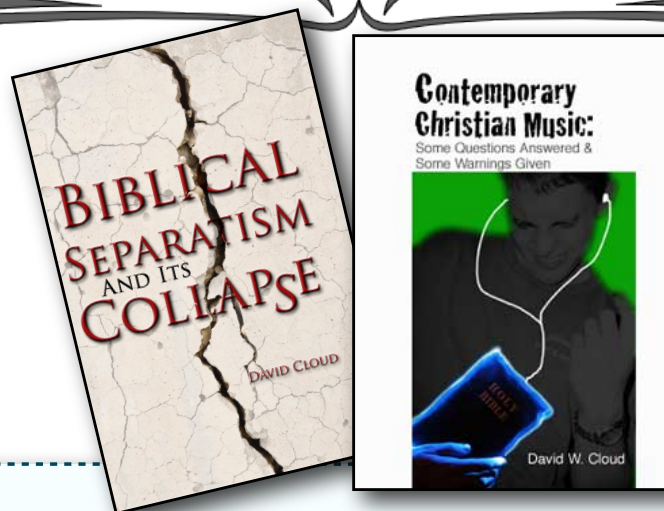
marches!" This has always been the Christian rock philosophy. "I will listen to whatever music I like; I will dress as I please; no one is going to judge me; and if they do I'll rail on them." Christian rockers have gotten not only their music from their secular brethren, but their attitude as well. This is why they are enemies of every fundamentalist Bible-believing church. They mock such churches continually. In the song "I Want to Be a Clone," Steve Taylor ridicules fundamentalist churches as clone-making machines. Gregory Volz of Petra says that those who preach against

rock are “bigoted” and the band mocked the bigots with the song “Witch Hunt”: “So send out the dogs and tally ho/ No one is safe, no stone is left unturned/ And we won’t stop until somebody gets burned.” DeGarmo and Key raised the flag against any standards for Christian music in the song “Don’t Stop the Music” -- “Don’t stop the music. Play it in your own way. I hear dissenting voices but they don’t bother me.” Michael W. Smith says, “You’re always going to have those very very conservative people who say you can’t do this, you can’t do that ... you can’t drink, can’t smoke. It’s a pretty bizarre way of thinking” (*The Birmingham News*, Feb. 1993). Deniece Williams says, “In the church I grew up in, you couldn’t go to dances, you couldn’t go to movies, and you couldn’t wear pants or sleeveless dresses. There were a lot of ‘Thou shalt nots’” (*CCM Magazine*, Jan. 1987). God forbid! Rich Mullins warned about “those Bible-believing, Bible-thumping born again-ers” (April 1996, Netcentral.net). In their song “Time Ta Jam,” DC Talk mocked the ‘hyper fundi’ who opposes rock music. Caedmon’s Call says

churches “in the Bible-belt” that teach against drinking, smoking, and cussing and say, “Don’t do this; don’t do that” are Pharisees (*Lighthouse Electronic Magazine*, 1996). Don Francisco says those who opposed rock & roll are “selling legalism, guilt and sour grapes” (“Freedom to Move”). No wonder Contemporary Christian Music acts as a powerful transformative agent when it comes into the life of an individual, family, or church. The same attitude permeates Southern Gospel today. Mark Lowry says, “Preachers keep giving people a list of rules instead of ‘Love the Lord with all your heart, then do as you please’” (*CCM Magazine*, May 1996). It is too bad that Lowry wasn’t around 2,000 years ago so he could have instructed the poor, dim-witted apostles and prophets who wrote the New Testament. They could have saved a lot of expensive parchment by shortening the Epistles to “Love one another, then do as you please,” instead of filling up the canon of Scripture with page after page of grace-lived, God-fearing rules and obligations (i.e., Romans 12-15; Ephesians 3-6; and the entire epistle of James).

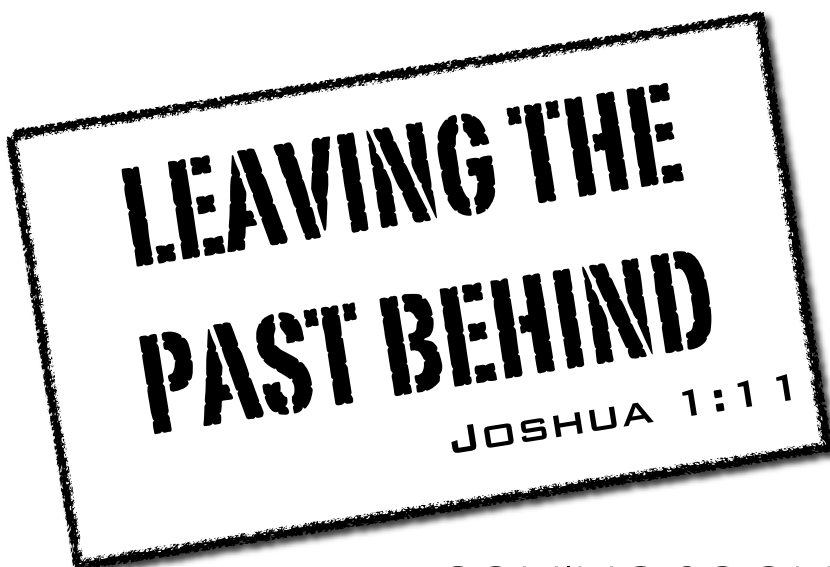
