weakness and difficulty in life. Now they are enslaved and trapped. Compassion, not sharp words and rebuke, is the best approach for such people. Mercy and grace need to be extended; kindness needs to be done for such individuals that they might see the light of the Word and the love of Christ and be drawn back to the Saviour whom they have left. What does it mean to have compassion?

Firstly compassion is seeing people in their need:

But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

Matthew 9:36

The Lord Jesus, full of compassion, never failed to be moved when He saw people in need. We are all needy people, but it requires a compassionate and spiritual individual to perceive the need of people around him. Many people around us have burdens and needs. As a believer in the Lord, we are not to be indifferent to the cries of the people - we need to be like the Lord Jesus, having compassion on them.

Secondly, compassion is doing what we can to help them in their need.

But whoso hath this world's good, and seeth his brother have need, and shutteth up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwelleth the love of God in him?

FRIDAY CHURCH NEWS NOTES

STARBUCKS, MICROSOFT, GOOGLE SUPPORT HOMOSEXUAL MARRIAGE

Starbucks, Microsoft, and Google are among the major corporations that endorsed the recently-signed homosexual "marriage" law in Washington State. In a statement sent to all of its employees, Starbucks said the legislation "is core to who we are

and what we value" (CNSNews, Jan. 27, 2012). The statement said the company is "deeply dedicated to embracing diversity and treating one another with respect and dignity." This means, of course, that these global companies are creating an environment in which it is not acceptable to speak against homosexuality. They have become so morally perverted and proud that they have set themselves against Almighty God and the Bible. This, in turn, proves that the Bible is true, because this

rebellion was foretold in ancient prophecies, as Psalm 2, which was written 3,000 years ago and describes the times in which we live in perfect detail. The prophecy not only describes the global rebellion of the end times, it also describes the return of Christ and the establishment of His kingdom. The "kings of the earth" are its rulers, referring not only to political leaders but also to captains of modern industries and the kings and queens of the pop culture. "Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us. He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the Lord shall have them in derision. Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure. Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion" (Psalms 2:1-6).

RUSSIA SAYS ATTACK ON TEHRAN IS ATTACK ON MOSCOW

The following is excerpted from "Russia," Arutz Sheva, Jan. 15, 2012: "Russia has given Iran its bear hug and warns Israel and the West that an attack on Tehran would be considered an attack on Moscow. The threat heightens the prospect of World War III in the event of a military strike on Iran. 'Iran is our neighbor,' Russia's outgoing ambassador to NATO. Dmitry Rogozin, told reporters in Brussels. 'And if Iran is involved in any military action, it's a direct threat to our security.' Kremlin Security Council head Nikolai Patrushev accused Israel of provoking the United States towards war against Iran, the Russian Interfax news agency reported Friday. 'But at the same time, we believe that any country has the right to have what it needs to feel comfortable, including Iran,' he added. Rogozin warned on Friday that more attacks on Iran could cause 'a scorching Arab Summer.' Russia also has come to the defense of Syrian President Bashar al-Assad, warning Western nations not to intervene in Syria

with military forces. Russia is a major arms supplier to Syria and has a heavy investment in Iran's nuclear facilities."

CCM MUSICIAN SAYS CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP A BRIDGE TO THE WORLD

Contemporary Worship leader Nick Herbert says praise music must "connect with the culture around us and seek to bridge the gap between the music we listen to and enjoy outside the church and the music we listen to and play inside the



to and play inside the church" ("New Sound, Same Spirit," WorshipCentral.org, Oct, 4, 2011). This is evidence of the warning we have been giving, that CCM is a bridge between Christ and the world and is therefore unscriptural and very dangerous. The apostle Paul says the believer's music is to be "spiritual," which means set apart to God, holy in character, not of the world (Col. 3:16). Unlike the priests who will minister during the millennium, the CCM crowd refuses to "teach my people the difference between and the profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean" (Ezekiel 44:23). Joy Williams says, "I believe in the power of nuance and telling a story that draws out emotion without spelling it out. ... I find myself really drawn to nuance because I feel like that is where I have been affected by music. Take Sigur Ros: I don't even understand what they are saying, but that music moves me and draws emotion from me, and I feel like there is glory in that" ("Finding Her Own Voice," *Christianity Today*, March 3, 2009). This is blind mysticism, and it is one of the uniting elements of end-time apostasy, together with charismaticism and contemplative prayer.

COURTS GIVE CHRISTIAN VICTORY OVER PERSECUTION IN MICHIGAN

The following is excerpted from "City Faces More Penalties," WorldNetDaily, Feb. 8, 2012: "A federal judge in Michigan has decided to allow a civil-rights claim against the city of Dearborn by four Christians arrested at the city's Arab festival to move forward. It was just days ago when WND reported that a Detroit judge had awarded some \$100,000 in attorney's fees in another case of a Christian who was arrested at the festival. In that case, the city was told to pay the fees on behalf of Christian Pastor George Saieg, who had been arrested at the 2009 event. Magistrate Judge R. Steven Whalen said his recommendation was for fees and costs totaling \$103,401.96 to be awarded in the case that was handled by attorney Robert J. Muise, who at the time was with the Thomas More Law Center. ... The ruling in the new case saw a federal judge deny Dearborn's request to dismiss the civil rights action brought by four Christian missionaries who were arrested at the Arab International Festival in 2010. The American Freedom Law Center said the four were arrested by Dearborn officers while speaking about their faith to Muslims. The Christians spent the night in jail and were accused of 'breaching the peace.' However,




Muise won acquittals from a jury for all the defendants in a criminal trial. After the trial, Muise, along with Yerushalmi, filed a 96-page civil rights lawsuit against the city ... 'The judge's ruling today is a huge victory for these Christians,' Muise said. 'It allows the civil rights claims for the most egregious constitutional violations to proceed against the city and its officials. AFLC is committed to ensuring that our Constitution and not Shariah law, which makes it a crime to preach the Gospel to Muslims, is the supreme law in this country."

A MENTAL ILLNESS FOR EVERY SITUATION

The following is excerpted from "Shyness, Grieving Soon to Be Classified as Mental Illness," FoxNews, Feb. 9, 2012: "Millions of healthy people - including shy or defiant children, grieving relatives and people with fetishes - may be wrongly labeled mentally ill by a new international diagnostic manual, specialists said on Thursday. In a damning analysis of an upcoming revision of the influential Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM), psychologists, psychiatrists and mental health experts said its new categories and 'tick-box' diagnosis systems were at best 'silly' and at worst 'worrying and dangerous.' Some diagnoses for conditions like 'oppositional defiant disorder' and 'apathy syndrome' - risk devaluing the seriousness of mental illness and medicalising behaviors most people would consider normal or just mildly

eccentric, the experts said. At the other end of the spectrum, the new DSM, due out next year, could give medical diagnoses for serial rapists and sex abusers--under labels like 'paraphilic coercive disorder'--and may allow offenders to escape prison by providing what could be seen



as an excuse for their behavior, they added. The DSM is published by the American Psychiatric Association (APA) and has descriptions, symptoms and other criteria for diagnosing mental disorders. It is used internationally and is seen as the diagnostic 'bible' for mental health medicine. ... Simon Wessely of the Institute of Psychiatry, King's College London said a look back at history should make health experts ask themselves: 'Do we need all these labels?' He said the 1840 Census of the United States included just one category for mental disorder, but by 1917 the APA was already recognizing 59. That rose to 128 in 1959, to 227 in 1980, and again to around 350 disorders in the fastest revisions of DSM in 1994 and 2000. Allen Frances, Emeritus professor at Duke University and chair of the committee that oversaw the previous

DSM revision, said the proposed DSM-5 would 'radically and recklessly expand the boundaries of psychiatry' and result in the 'medicalisation of normality, individual difference, and criminality.'"

LIBERAL GOVERNMENTS AGAINST HOME SCHOOLING



The following is from "Anti-home Schooling Efforts," OneNewsNow, Feb. 10, 2012: "Sweden's Liberal Party is calling for a law change that will allow social service workers to take children away from their home-schooling families. Robert Kiska of the Alliance Defense Fund (ADF) says the requested changes add to the already

stringent penalties on home-schooling parents. For example, one family has been fined the equivalent of \$26,000 because of their participation in home schooling. Kiska says this latest effort is totalitarian in nature. 'That the government should have the right to take children away from their families simply for the act of home education--that is without due process, without any real evidence gathering--that is almost a military state power,' he contends. He points out that other European countries are practicing the same policies, and it is just a matter of time until it spills over into the United States. 'You know, I always say that when Europe coughs, the United States gets the cold, especially when you have the United States Supreme Court, where I think right now ... the majority of the justices are in favor of importing international precedent,' the ADF legal counsel comments. 'And you have an administration equally keen on importing international precedent."

GERMAN GOVERNMENT'S PERSECUTION OF HOME SCHOOLERS

The following is excerpted from "Government willing to use 'force' on homeschool kids," WorldNetDaily, Nov. 8, 2011: "German education officials say they are willing to use 'force' as their options dwindle in a years-long fight against a homeschooling family, according to a report today from the Home School Legal Defense Association. Jurgen and Rosemarie Dudek have been homeschooling their children in Germany for more than a decade, and for a good portion of that time have been battling in court with the government and its attempt to enforce a Nazi-era law requiring public school attendance. The couple was sentenced to prison but won an appeal and now is appealing a fine. But the HSLDA, which has been active in supporting the family's homeschool efforts, reported today that a letter to the family threatens the use of force. The letter to the parents from Hesse Regional School Office Director Anita Hoffman said the state may remedy its war against the family with a decision to 'take custody of the children from the parents' or to 'transport the children to school by force.' The family's religious and philosophical conviction that the children would be harmed by a German public school education has inspired others. Their story is being made into a documentary called 'Building Education by Trusting God' by Woodcutter Film Studios. Jurgen Dudek told HSLDA it's the first time that the head of the school authorities herself sent the family a letter. 'I believe they're in a fix, not knowing exactly how to go on with our case,' he said. 'So they can only resort to putting all kinds of pressure on us, this time even threatening the forced transportation of our children to school.' The parents were given a retrial in 2009 in the dispute. It was then that 90day jail sentences for each parent were overturned and replaced with fines, which now are on appeal. The family's older son, who is finished with school and is apprenticed


as a carpenter, earned a top score on a state educational exam. Still, authorities continue to press for the family to acquiesce to the state and put the other children in public school. The HSLDA said Germany is one of the nations in which there is active persecution of homeschooling families. Last year a judge in the United States granted another homeschooling family asylum from Germany. Another nation where similar crackdowns are under way is Sweden, where social services workers took custody of a 7-year-old boy in 2009 over homeschooling. He remains in the custody of the government, which now apparently is seeking to assume permanent control over him. Parents in Germany are 'fined thousands of dollars, threatened with jail time or the loss of custody of their children,' the HSLDA reported. 'Ironically, the highest German courts have ruled that homeschooling may be considered an abuse of parental rights and can be banned in the interest of stamping out parallel societies.""



FILTHY POP MUSIC

The following is excerpted from "Profanity and Pop Music," Brent Bozell, Townhall.com, Dec. 30, 2011: "On her blog, *The Record*, NPR music critic Ann Powers declared [that] '21st century pop music is very dirty.' In fact, '2011 saw so much boundary-breaking in pop that the lines seem forever pulled down.' Powers made quite a list. ... There were top 100 pop songs about sex addiction ... even sex with extraterrestrials. ... Putting a woman on a pedestal is archaic. Degradation is a requirement."


New Age Health Care




