By patience



FRIDAY CHURCH NEWS NOTES



The movie "Act of Valor" is being recommended by conservative pundits such as Rush Limbaugh and Michael Medved, and though I haven't seen the movie I have read reviews and I want to make two comments about it. First, we don't need the public airing of military tactics. I am glad for the brave, highly-trained special forces men who are on the front lines of America's military, and it is too bad that their hands are so tied by lack of wisdom and selfserving on the part of the political leaders and by the lawyerized, feminized, homosexualized military itself, but that is a judgment of God on America because of her wickedness and apostasy. We can't change those conditions, but we don't need to help the enemy by airing military tactics. I thought that one of the mottos of the Seals is "never seen," but they are anything but not seen lately. A slew of books and documentaries have been published, and though they are edited to withhold some secrets, they still give away tactics and there can be no doubt that they help the enemy. The airing of military secrets needs to stop! The world shouldn't even know that the Seals were behind the killing of Bin Ladin. We shouldn't know anything about their their tactics. Nothing! Second, God's people don't need to watch R-rated movies. We need to stop following in lock-step a few degrees behind the world. Just because something is patriotic and soul-stirring and has some redeeming features doesn't make it right and acceptable before God. Christians are first and foremost citizens of a heavenly country, and we are to be a holy people unto the Lord. We are to be light and salt to this confused, sin-cursed society. We are to march to a different drummer. A love for the pop culture is at the very heart of the break-down in separation and holiness and the lack of spiritual discernment that is opening the door for worldly music and other things to enter the homes and churches. Pastors who watch R-rated movies are setting a terrible example for their families and their congregations and their neighbors. They are on a slippery slide toward ever-increasing worldliness and sensuality. The Word of God exhorts us to set NO wicked thing before our eyes (Psalm 101:3). We are to have NO fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness but rather to reprove them (Ephesians 5:11). We are to abstain from ALL appearance of evil (1 Thess. 5:22). We are to lay apart ALL filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness (James 1:21). There is not an R-rated movie that passes those tests. According to the reviews and ratings, this movie includes plenty of cursing and profanity as well as bikini-clad women. The Bible says that lusting after women is an act of fornication (Matthew 5:28). Further, God will hold those accountable who are guilty of taking His holy name in vain (Exodus 20:7). To hear cursing and not expose and condemn it is to be a partner with those who are guilty of this sin (Prov. 29:24).

MUSLIMS STONE CHRISTIANS ON THE TEMPLE MOUNT

The following is excerpted from *Israel Today*, Feb. 19, 2012: "A mob of some 50 Palestinian Muslims stoned a group of Christian tourists atop Jerusalem's Temple Mount on Sunday morning. Three of the Israeli police officers who acted to protect the Christian group were wounded by the stone-throwers. Police arrested 11 Palestinians, several of them minors, for their role in the attack. The attack is believed to have been instigated by the former Muslim mufti of Jerusalem, Ekrama Sabri, who told Palestinian media over the weekend that Jewish groups were planning to break into the mosques that occupy the holy compound and desecrate them. Sabri urged all local Muslims to protect the mosques from 'the Israeli conspiracy against the city and its holy places.' Muslim religious figures regularly claim that Israel is plotting to destroy the Dome of the Rock and the Al Aqsa Mosque to pave the way for the rebuilding of the Jewish Temple, which the Muslims now insist never previously existed. Because of the constant threat of Muslim violence, and



despite the fact that the Temple Mount is the most holy place on earth to Jews and many Christians, the Israeli police comply with Muslim demands for harsh restrictions on non-Muslim visitors to the site. For instance, Jews and Christians are forbidden to carry Bibles atop the Temple Mount or to utter even silent prayers within its walls. Jews and Christians are regularly detained for violating these conditions."

HOMESCHOOLS FORBIDDEN TO CALL HOMOSEXUALITY SIN UNDER NEW ALBERTA POLICY

The following is excerpted from "Homeschoolers Can't Be Taught 'Gay' Sex Sinful," *WorldNetDaily*, Feb. 27, 2012:

"Homeschooling families will soon be forbidden from teaching that homosexual sex is sinful as part of their schooling program, according to the government of Alberta, Canada. Under the province's Education Act, homeschoolers and religious schools will be banned from 'disrespecting' people's differences, Alberta Education Minister Thomas Lukaszuk's office told LifeSiteNews just last week. 'Whatever the nature of schooling-homeschool, private school, Catholic school--we do not tolerate disrespect for differences,' said Donna McColl, Lukaszuk's assistant director of communications. 'You can affirm the family's ideology in your family life, you just can't do it as part of your educational study and instruction.' ... Patty Marler, government liaison for the Alberta Home Education Association ... wondered how the government would stipulate the difference between homeschoolers' school and family time. 'We educate our children all the time, and that's just the way we live. It's a lifestyle,' she said. 'Making that distinction between the times when we're homeschooling and when we're just living is really hard to do.' She added, 'Throw in the fact that I do use the Bible as part of my curriculum, and now I'm very blatantly going to be teaching stuff that will be against [the Alberta Human Rights Act].""



KNOWLEDGE SHALL INCREASE

Recent inventions include the following: (1) A camera on a military drone with an 1.8 gigapixel camera ("Latest US Military drone," *Digital Trends*, Jan. 3, 2012). The camera, which is part of the Argus-IS drone helicopter package, is 900 times the resolution of a standard 2-megapixel camera. The drone can lock on multiple targets simultaneously from altitudes as high as 20,000 feet. (2) A nano-ear capable of detecting sounds six orders of magnitude below the threshold of human hearing to



detect sounds made at the bacterial level ("The World's First 'Nano-Ear," Popular Science, Jan. 11, 2012). The invention uses an optically-trapped gold nanoparticle as a listening device. The particle is 60 billionths of a meter or roughly a thousand times smaller than a human hair. (3)

Microrockets that can zip around the human stomach, powered by hydrogen bubbles ("Microrockets," *Popular Science*, Jan. 18, 2012). A team from the University of California, San Diego, has created the tiny self-propelled motors that can move around in an acidic environment without the need for any external fuel. The power is supplied by hydrogen bubbles produced by a reaction between an acidic solution and the zinc that the microrocket is made of. (4) X-Ray laser that super-heats aluminum foil to 3.6 million degrees ("World's Most

Powerful X-Ray Laser," *Popular Science*, Jan. 25, 2012). The Linac Coherent Light Source SXR chamber at the SLAC National Accelerator Laboratory creates and measures 2-million-degree matter, which can be used to watch biological molecules at work and to understand the processes of nuclear fusion. (5) **First bionic leg that fuses to the body to be fitted in Australia** ("Woman's Bionic

Leg," Fox News, Feb. 13, 2012). The leg, which will be fitted to a woman who lost her leg after falling beneath a train on the London Underground in 1996, is supposed to



fuse to muscle and bone. Orthopedic surgeon Munjed Al Muderis described the procedure as "the future for amputee patients." About 2,500 years ago, during the Medo-Persian Empire, an angel told the prophet Daniel, "But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased" (Daniel 12:4). The Psalmist said, "Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth for ever" (Psalms 119:160).

E-MAILING SERMONS, ARTICLES TO KINDLE OR KINDLE APP




I use the Kindle app for the iPad frequently because I like the convenience of using the Amazon store for eBook purchases. Also, you can e-mail any sermon or article or book in Word doc or PDF format to your Kindle account and it will be converted and delivered to your Kindle device or app (for the iPad, iPhone, etc.). The Kindle

reader is basic but effective. You can highlight and add notes, and the app remembers where you stopped reading. This could be a good solution for pastors who want to upload their sermons to an eReader. You or your secretary or someone else can upload articles, sermons, even books, to your iPad (with the Kindle app installed) or Kindle device on an iPad. All of the relevant information about this process can be found on the Amazon site. Go to your Amazon account under the section on "Manage Your Kindle." Toward the top of the screen there is a "View" window that lets you choose Books, Magazines, Blogs, Personal Documents, etc. The documents you e-mail for conversion and download can be found under the Personal Documents section. Each file is listed and you have the option to delete it or deliver it to your Kindle device or app. A pastor recently asked how he can load the PDF files from the Advanced Bible Studies Digital Library to his Kindle, and I advised him to use the e-mail method. PDFs can be loaded directly to the Kindle, but they don't necessarily work properly. They need to be converted to work best. To e-mail the PDF books from the Advanced Bible Studies Digital Library, you first must extract the individual files from the Adobe portfolio (the portfolio file on the CD is "Advanced Bible Study Series Digital Edition.pdf"). Open the portfolio; click on the book cover and go to File - Extract File. When the files are extracted to your hard drive they can be mailed to your Kindle account for conversion and download to your device or app.

ACADEMIC FASCISM AGAINST "DARWIN DOUBTERS"

The 477-page book Slaughter of the Dissidents by Dr. Jerry Bergman (2008, Leafcutter Press) documents the widespread persecution against "Darwin Doubters" within American academia. In the chapter "A Context for Discrimination," Kevin Wirth writes: "The battle for the philosophical heart and soul of science, in the view of many, revolves around the theory of evolution. And ground zero for that battle has been, and continues to be, our academic institutions. Academia is the gateway in our culture where we determine who qualifies and who is allowed entry to practice in a scientific venue or educate our young people about the principles of science. And, academia is where we are currently witness to a grave injustice, often a purging, of students and educators who are skeptical about one or more aspects of Darwinian evolution. A contentious result of this intellectual carnage is the abrogation of a host of freedoms: freedom of speech, freedom of thought, academic freedom, and freedom of religious expression, to name a few. ... This book tells the story about what has been going on behind the scenes in recent decades as students, professors, and science professionals have been systematically harassed and eliminated from their professions for harboring skepticism about Darwinism. These activities are all the result of what

Denyse O'Leary refers to as 'academic fascism,' that poses a serious threat, not only to freedom of speech and academic freedom, but also sends a chilling message about a pernicious agenda in academia and science as a whole."




EVOLUTIONIST SAYS DARWINISM A RELIGION

Philosopher of science Michael Ruse writes: "Evolution is promoted by its practitioners as more than mere science. Evolution is promulgated as an ideology, a secular religion--a full-fledged alternative to Christianity, with meaning and morality. 
