WHAT ARE YOU WRITING ABOUT?

A testimony of salvation explains to your prospective church family, what you were before you were saved, how God led you to accepting Christ as your Saviour, significant events after your salvation and why you want to be baptized. It is a public confession of what has happened inside of your heart. The Bible teaches that:

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:9-10

God wants us to glorify Him for His work in our lives, and the salvation testimony is one way of doing this. It is by no means a way of salvation, for salvation is solely by God's grace through the faith we have placed in Him, with nothing (no good works) added. (Ephesians 2:8-9). In baptism, the Bible teaches that there are three requirements.

THE PROPER CANDIDATE

The person must be of age, able to understand sin and why is there a need for the Lord Jesus to save .

...they that gladly received the word...

Acts 2:41

THE PROPER METHOD

There is only one method in the scriptures and that is of immersion. The word "baptize" in the scriptures means to dip under.

THE PROPER AUTHORITY

This simply means that GOD gives the authority to baptise. How are we to know which is the church with the proper GOD-given authority for baptism?

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Matthew 28:18-20

Our Saviour tells us that all authority is given to Him, and then He commissions us to go. He gives a few clear indications of His authorised church. It is evangelistic (teaching all nations – get the people saved), obedient to the ordinances (baptizing them), and faithful to the Word (teaching all things whatsoever I have commanded you). The last point dictates a clear evidence of an authorised church for baptism, that they remain in the teachings of the Saviour, in its entirety and not attempting to add new ways, words or rituals. Use the headings to guide your writing of your testimony.

You can be confident that it will be blessing to the hearers.
