This self-preservation involves favouring personal possessions over the kingdom of God.

The rich young ruler walked away from the Lord Jesus when he was told that his riches were the stumbling block for him entering the kingdom of God. The Lord said afterward, "How hard is it for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." A rich man would find it hard to separate from his riches because it is his security.

This self-preservation involves favouring personal relationships over the kingdom of God. In teaching the disciples regarding service for the Lord, the Lord Jesus instructed.

He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. the Lord, to do the same? 

FRIDAY CHURCH NEWS NOTES

THE LATEST IN THE SAGA OF "THE TWO JACKS"

Earlier this year I published The Two Jacks, documenting the life and ministry of Jack Hyles, who pastored First Baptist Church of Hammond, Indiana, for 42 years, and Jack Schaap, who took over the pastorate of the church when his father-in-law died in 2001. But the book is not merely about two men. It is a warning about a cultic model of ministry that has spread very far. Hyles set the pattern for errors that are still rampant. Most importantly, the book is a positive call to build biblical churches. A major motivation in writing the book was to challenge young preachers not to be man followers and man pleasers, to walk in the fear of God rather than the fear of man, to be serious Bible students and Bereans, to be passionate for Christ and Truth, and to reject

pragmatism: whether it be contemporary church growth pragmatism or emerging pragmatism or Independent Fundamental Baptist pragmatism. The book is a warning about Quick Prayerism, promotionalism, numbers-ism, the abuse of pastoral authority, blind loyalty to man, cover-up and deception and rampant immorality, the neglect of church discipline, and unrepentant heresy. Now we can add to the section on "rampant immorality" the fact that Jack Schaap has been dismissed from the pastorate because of his "physically improper" relationship with a 16-year-old girl. The Hammond Community Net reports that "the First Baptist Church of Hammond has dismissed Jack Schaap as its pastor in the wake of a Lake County police investigation." That occurred on Tuesday, July 31. In light of the history that we have documented in *The Two* Jacks, the only thing that is surprising about this sad account is that the church has taken action against the man.



Many teenage girls and even some children have been the target of sexual abuse at First Baptist, including those polluted by Jack Hyles' son, Dave. We don't know how long this type of thing has gone on even in Schaap's life. It's doubtful that a 54-year-old man would start messing with girls just out of the blue. This is the same church that covered over and justified Jack Hyles' sins and the ministry-disqualifying sins of other pastors associated with the church and school for decades, a church that was willing to stand by and watch the character assassination of anyone who dared to bring an accusation against the "man of God." This is the church that accepted the lie that to reprove and discipline a preacher is to "touch the Lord's anointed." It appears that Schaap thought he could walk in Hyles' footsteps and do as he pleased, and he succeeded for over a decade and probably could have

continued to do so except that the sheriff's department and the FBI got involved this time. (It is reported that "the girl was taken to Illinois and Michigan for Schaap's interludes," Mark Kiesling, "50 Shades of Jack Schaap," nwi.com.) There is no reason to believe that anything of real substance will change. Another man--doubtless another Hyles worshipper--will step behind that polluted pulpit and the cult will go on. Every warning that we gave in The Two Jacks is as relevant today as ever, and it's not just about First Baptist of Hammond. It's about a large number of IFB churches that have followed this cultic pattern and it's about large numbers of IFB preachers who have not spoken out against it but rather have chosen to bask in the glory of "bigness" rather than take a stand for truth. NASA FOLLOWING IN PERCIVAL'S FOOTSTEPS

NASA's Curiosity rover is set to attempt a landing on Mars on Sunday, August 5, in the ongoing effort to find evidence of life on the red planet or evidence that life could have evolved there. The \$2.5 billion project is a technological marvel, even if it crashes, because simply to send a spacecraft from earth to Mars, a 154-million-mile journey, is a major feat it itself and is clear evidence that man did not arise from the animal kingdom. The best-trained, sign-reading-qualified top-of-his-class ape can't even conceive of a space craft, let alone build one and get it to Mars. The size of a small car, the Curiosity is decked out with a power drill, rock-zapping laser, and an onboard lab to detect organic compounds, all with the objective of



exploring whether the planet "ever had the right environment for microorganisms to take hold" ("NASA to Athletic Mars Rover," *USA Today*, July 20, 2012). Here NASA leaves the world of real science that it used to create its space program and enters the world of evolutionary myth, which is based on nothing but empty presuppositions. There is zero scientific evidence that life arose from non-life, that intelligence arose from non-intelligence, that great intelligence arose from low intelligence. Such ideas are not even theories, because not only do they lack evidence but they are contrary to proven scientific facts. Thus, evolutionists haven't progressed any further than Percival Lowell, the astronomer who "saw" canals on Mars. See "Percival Lowell's Martians".

ANNIVERSARY OF JUDSON'S MISSIONARY JOURNEY



This year is the 200th anniversary of the departure of the first missionaries sent from American churches to foreign lands. Adoniram Judson and Luther Rice were commissioned by Congregational churches in 1811 and set sail for India in February 1812. Judson had married Ann Hasseltine just two weeks earlier. Her parents would never see their daughter again, nor the grandchildren that Ann would bear,


but they had placed her into the Lord's hands, come what may. On the way to India, the young couple came to the conviction through Bible study that baptism is for believers only, rather than infants, and by immersion rather than sprinkling or pouring. When they arrived in Serampore, India, they were immersed on their profession of faith in Christ by William Ward, a co-worker with William Carey. Luther Rice came to the same conclusion independently of the Judsons. He returned to the States and traveled to Baptist churches to challenge them for world missions. In response, Baptist churches in America formed a missionary society of their own. Judson's 67year-old father resigned his pastorate in a Congregational church and was baptized scripturally, together with his wife and daughter (Adoniram's sister), Abigail. The Judsons settled in Burma, a Buddhist stronghold, in July 1813, and it was not until six difficult years later that they had their first convert. Six years after that Judson's fledgling church still had only 18 members. Their second child, a son, died at age eight months. Judson was imprisoned for nearly two years under terrible conditions--half-starved, fettered in iron, sometimes tied up and suspended by his mangled feet. Soon after he was released, Ann died, followed by their third child, Maria. This nearly crushed Judson, but his faith in God endured and the gospel work began to prosper. When Judson died in 1850, there were 63 Baptist churches in Burma with 7,000 baptized believers.

PERCIVAL LOWELL'S MARTIANS

One of the most interesting examples of how a man can see what he wants to see, how a man's will affects his mind and vision, is the case of Percival Lowell (1865-1916). He was born into a wealthy, highsociety Boston family, graduated from Harvard, was a brilliant mathematician a n d

and successful businessman, traveled widely in the Far East, learned several

languages, and kept company with affluent, influential people. *On the Origin of Species* was published when Lowell was a boy, and he accepted Darwin's doctrine wholeheartedly. He used his wealth to construct an astronomical observatory with a 24-inch telescope in the American west near the Grand Canyon with the objective of proving that life exists on other planets. It was completed in 1894, and from then until his death 22 years later Lowell studied Mars and published reports and books. Eventually he "saw" and named 700 canals on Mars and came to believe that Martians were building



canals in an attempt to save their planet. He even deduced many fascinating details about the lives of the Martian aliens. How could an intelligent, well-educated man see canals and alien civilizations that

do not exist? The answer is that he saw what he wanted to see. It is the same phenomenon that allows any evolutionist to see evidence for Darwinian evolution when none exists. The Bible explains it as the deceit of the fallen human heart and willful spiritual blindness. It is possible to believe a lie and to believe it with all of one's heart. "In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them" (2 Corinthians 4:4). I am so thankful to the Lord for opening my blind eyes nearly 40 years ago and showing me the truth in Jesus Christ.

MARCH AROUND THE TEMPLE MOUNT

The Women in Green movement led the 18th annual march around the Temple Mount in Jerusalem on July 28. The march, which is in recognition of Tisha B'Av, the day of mourning over the destruction of the Jewish temple, begins with the reading of the Book of Lamentations in front of the American Consulate and then proceeds to circle the walls of the Old City. Thousands joined in the march. Nadia Matar, the leader of Women in Green, told Arutz Sheva TV, "We walk around the Old City to

say that Jerusalem is ours. The Temple Mount is ours. Like a bride going around the groom we go around the Temple Mount, showing our loyalty and our love to Jerusalem. ... Altogether we are saying the land of Israel is ours, Jerusalem is ours, and we pray for the day that Tisha B'Av will turn from a fast day into a day of holiday when we can all dance to the Temple Mount."

TEL-AVIV MAYOR SAYS JERUSALEM IS CAPITAL OF ISRAEL

Responding to a BBC report that listed East Jerusalem as the capital for the Palestinian Olympic team and that listed no capital for Israel, Tel Aviv's mayor, Ron Huldai, posted a YouTube video stating the following: "The city of Tel-Aviv is one of the

coolest cities in the world ... Israel's financial and cultural center, but there is one thing we are not, we are not Israel's capital. Jerusalem is Israel's capital. It became the capital 3,500 years ago. For centuries, Jews all over the world hoped to go back to the Holy Land and would pray to be 'next year in Jerusalem." On July 26 Barack Obama's press secretary refused to name the capital of Israel when pressed on the matter by the two most senior White House correspondents ("So, Mr. President, What IS the Capital of Israel," *Town Hall*, July 26, 2012).

POSSIBLE REMAINS OF JEWS MASSACRED ON TEMPLE MOUNT DISCOVERED

The following is excerpted from "Remains of Jews Massacred," *Arutz Sheva*, July 30, 2012: "The remains of thousands of Jews massacred by the Romans on the Temple Mount during the destruction of the Second Temple may have been uncovered, according to veteran archaeological journalist Benny Liss. According to daily newspaper *Israel HaYom*, Liss screened a video clearly showing thousands of human

skeletons in what appears to be a mass grave. Liss 'told the amazed audience that the film had been shot in a spacious, underground cavern in the area of the Mercy Gate [Sha'ar Harachamim in Hebrew, a sealed gate in the wall of the Old City, opposite the Mount of Olives, ed.], near the eastern wall of the Temple Mount, but just outside it,' the newspaper reported. Liss raised the possibility that the skeletons were the remains of 6,000 Jews, mostly women and children, killed on the Temple Mount when the Romans destroyed the Second Temple. The massacre is described in the writings of Josephus Flavius, who defected from the Jewish to the Roman side and witnessed the destruction."

GOD PROTECTS TREES FROM INSECTS

The following is from Creation Moments, March 19, 2012, www.creationmoments.com: "The number of different kinds of insects in the world seems almost endless. There are millions. The larva of many of these insects feed on trees and bushes at least until they develop into adults. One would think, then, that we wouldn't have any trees left, since they are so unfairly outnumbered by such hordes. But we also know from experience that the creation has been designed with careful and intricate balances. In this case, the many different kinds of trees each produce poisons in order to protect themselves from insects. But there is still balance, since insects, too, need to make a living. Not every insecticide produced by a tree is poisonous to every insect. So a tree's insecticides simply limit the number of insects that can feed on it. Some trees have pockets of gluey fluids that, when opened by insect mandibles, glue the insect's mouth closed--a very effective way of keeping something from eating you! But most of the insecticides manufactured by trees involve subtle and complex chemistry. One poison fools the insect's system into thinking that it is an essential amino acid--with fatal results. Where could such advanced knowledge of chemistry come from? For that matter, could such precise balance--that allows for life but keeps it in control--arise all by itself? As our knowledge of science grows, our appreciation of


God's work of creation only increases!"


